

SNOW PARK ETIQUETTE

- Read and follow all park signs & warnings.
- Use features suitable to your ability and skill level.
- Start out with the smaller features and work your way up.
- Inspect the features before jumping.
- When inspecting or instructing in the park, be sure that you are out of the way of other users.
- Don't stop on the tops of jumps.
- Clear out the landing zones of the jumps quickly.
- Use spotters if the landing zone is not visible from above.
- Use visual signals. (e.g. crossed arm above head - NOT CLEAR & One arm wave CLEAR).
- Call for priority when waiting for your turn to use a feature. (e.g. "NEXT", "ON DECK" or "DROPPING IN").
- Speed judgement is important to landing in the "sweet" spot on a jump. Watch others, get advice, or take lessons.
